# Description

Fleas are tiny insects with hind
legs modified for jumping; they are
found on pets, in carpet
and in shady, moist soil in the
yard; they leave black droppings
around pet sleeping areas and
hop when distrubed.

# Infestation

Fleas can attack pets and peopleflea bites are mostly on the lower legs, and can turn red and itch. Most

adult fleas live on the animal host (pets or other animas in the area), however, flea eggs and larva can be found in bedding, carpeting and areas where pets spend time resting and sleeping. An effective program to elimate fleas must include controlling fleas on pets, and removing eggs and larva from the living area.

If you have fleas, but do not have pets, you could have animals entering your attic or crawlspace.

# ECO-FRIENDLY GUIDE TO FLEAS

## Least Toxic Solutions

- \*Keep your house well vacuumed, especially where your pet rests; dispose of vacum bags after use to prevent fleas from escaping back into your home.
- \*Steam clean carpets to remove organic material which is food for flea larvae
- \*Wash your pet's bedding regularly in hot water; wash your bedding if pets sleep with you
- \*Use a flea comb to remove fleas from your pet. Dip the flea comb into soapy water to remove and kill any fleas thay you encounter while combing your pet
- \*Shampoo your pet regularly with a gently shampoo. Shampoos containing chemical pesticides are not necessary, because ANY soapy water kills fleas, and washing your pet removes fleas and flea eggs from their fur.
- \*Try flea traps that utlize light, heat and sticky boards to trap any adult fleas living in your carpeting

### Treatment

insecticides.

- \*Test your yard for flea infestation by walking around in white socks and noticing if fleas jump on your legs. If areas of your yard are heavily infested, treat them using a spray of beneficial nematodes. These organisms kill flea larva, but are not harmful to the environment.
- \*Diatomateous Earth or boric acid can be used in cracks and crevices around the house and in the yard. These dessicants penetrate the surface of the fleas and dry them out.

  \*Insect repellent granules- Cedar is Mother Natures alternative to toxic chemical
- \*Yardsafe Insect repellent Hose End- For use on Lawns, gardens and patios
- \*RONS BUG B GONE-Granules- Clove, Thyme, Corn and wintergreen oil
